



Calvary's Adult Sunday School Class Descriptions

COLLEGE & YOUNG ADULT CLASSES

College Students and College-Age Young Adults – Taught by Shelby and Stewart Stevens; Lessons and discussion connect participants to the Bible as well as to one another. *[3rd floor, EB1]*

Keeping Up With the Corinthians – Taught by Ryan Harrington and Sam and David Todd; for young adults, post-college age through 30s. Single or married, come connect with your community. *[3rd floor, EB1]*

MEDIAN ADULT CLASSES

Sons and Daughters of Thunder (SADOT) – Taught by Fran Rohlfing and meets on the 3rd floor of EB1; expect both couples and single adults in their 30's and 40's involved in Bible study and various book studies while also engaging one another in discussion; If you're looking to connect with a diversity of voices, this is your place. *[EB1, 3rd floor]*

Crossroads – Taught by Heather Barron, and meets on the 3rd floor of EB1; expect both single and married adults of all ages gathering to discuss and challenge one another in their understanding of the Bible, current events, and how to best be the church. *[EB1, 3rd floor]*

ADULT CLASSES

Upper Room – Taught by Dan Carmen, and meets on the 3rd floor of EB1; expect generally married adults in their 40's and 50's, but single adults are also welcome; Bible study and discussion is laid back and there are plenty of opportunities to connect with this group outside of church. *[EB1, 3rd floor]*

Journey – Taught by H.K. & Bettie Kingkade and David & Sue Shaw, and meets on the 3rd floor of EB1; expect generally couples in their 40's who gather to share prayer requests, engage in Bible

study, and share in discussion; this group self-identifies as a fun, caring bunch who enjoy a good laugh and doing life together. *[EB1, 3rd floor]*

Keeping It Together in Action (KITIA) – Taught by Wade VanMeter and Neil Reed, and meets on the 3rd floor of EB2; expect an intergenerational class of both single and married adults generally in their 20's to 50's gathered to study the Bible, share life with one another, and enjoy a good laugh; This is an active class with busy families and kids. They love missions, service, and hanging out. Recognizing this season of life is busy, their weekly studies allow for missing without missing out. When you join this crew, you'll find that they have a lot of discussion and adults of varying ages. They are sincere when they say that everyone is welcome. *[EB2, 3rd floor, Room 303B]*

Lighthouse – Taught by Tonya Steele, Janet Graham, and Brett Bell, and meets in EB2 in Rm. 211; expect both single and married adults in their 50's and 60's engaged in Bible study and prayer; If you appreciate sarcasm and keeping it real while delving into God's Word, by a group of people doing the best they can, this might be the class for you. *[EB2, 2nd floor, Rm. 211]*

Gracious Friends – Taught by Lee and Jenni Jinright, and meets in EB2, 3rd floor; expect singles, married attending without their spouse and couples between the ages of 30 – 76 (with and without children) from different denominational backgrounds having attended Calvary all their life to less than a year. This supportive, easy going group of friends participate via zoom or in person and acts as a home base for some members who are unable to attend on a regular basis. They spend time together quarterly outside of class and many enjoy volunteering around the church along with plugging in to Calvary's many mission opportunities. *[EB2, 3rd floor]*

Say Anything- Taught by Jay Blanton, Becky Dutch, and Scott Fitzpatrick, and meets in EB2 in Rm. 206. Expect generally couples in their 40's and 50's; Some have been in this class for a relatively short period of time; others for several years. Sometimes their studies are deep in scripture, but often they will delve into books or articles regarding contemporary issues - all focused on how our faith has application. Opinions are varied and welcomed, as are doubts and questions. Their relationships extend beyond Sunday mornings, and their social connections are what hold them together. *[EB2, 2nd floor, Rm. 206]*

Carriers of Light- Taught by Kim Taylor, Kathy Chase, and Robin and Matt Middlebrooks, and meets in EB2 in Rm. 303A; expect married and single adults in their late 40's to 60's; They are an inclusive and honest bunch that enjoys lively conversation, Bible study, and sharing their lives with one another through prayer. Together they pursue a loving relationship with God and with one another. Simply put, they are imperfect people totally reliant on a perfect God. *[EB2, 3rd floor, Rm. 303A]*

LOGOS CLASSES (60+)

Theotropist's Class – Taught by Greg Rayer, Hank Ellington and Carol Davs, this LOGOS Class uses Baptistway Press Materials and features lovely discussion with couples and individuals participating. *[EB2, 2nd floor, 203]*

Friends n' Christ – Mike Ligon, Ben Carr, and others lead this large discussion oriented couples class that also welcomes individuals. *[EB2, 3rd floor, Rm. 205]*

Vota Vita – Amelia Wisner is the teaching coordinator for this very welcoming ladies class. It runs 15-20 every Sunday and uses the Explore the Bible Curriculum. *[EB2, 2nd floor, Rm. 202A]*

Remnant Class – Couples Class led by Phil Harig, Les Hill, Alan Winchester, and Ed Brand. Guest teachers also provide leadership and the curriculum most Sundays comes from Baptistway Press. *[EB2, 2nd floor, Rm. 202B]*

BIG (Believer's In God) – This class is largely made up of Single Adults and those who formerly were part of our High Point Single Adult Ministry. Carma Mulliken and BJ Webb lead the teaching team. *[EB2, 2nd floor, 207]*

KEYSTONE – John Horne is the primary teacher for this group with Jim Wombles filling the teaching chair from time to time. This men's class connects the Bible to life, politics, and especially to UK athletics. *[EB2, 2nd floor, Rm. 204]*
